Dear Parents of Year 5 Children

We have planned for the children of Year 5 to visit Blists Hill Victorian Town on Thursday 19th October, (please note date change,) as part of our local history project. During our time there, we will be finding out what life might have been like for the people of Priorslee a hundred years ago. As well as finding out about daily life and soaking up the general atmosphere, we will be learning about some of the jobs and trades of the period. We will then be using this information to inform work done back at school which will include some poetry writing sessions led by a published poet.

The children will be leaving school at 9am and be returning at approximately 3pm (traffic permitting.) They will need to wear a school polo shirt and sweatshirt/cardigan but may wear jeans/leggings/trousers of their choice. They will also need:

- waterproof coat - this is an open air museum and we can't of course guarantee the weather. It may also be worth considering bringing waterproof trousers especially if your child already owns a pair.
- packed lunch
- water bottle
- small rucksack
- sensible shoes/trainers suited to walking on rough and uneven surfaces.

The children will need to bring a packed lunch and non-fizzy drinks for the day. If your child would like to order a school packed lunch (cost = £2.10) please indicate on the reply slip below, but please ensure that they bring extra non-fizzy drinks. If you are ordering a school packed lunch, please make sure your child has a bag to carry their lunch in.

The cost of the visit is £6 to include the cost of transport and insurance. As you know we can only ask for voluntary contributions towards the cost and no child will be treated any differently if they do not pay, however the visit can only go ahead if there is a sufficient level of voluntary contributions. Please return the slip by Monday 16th October so that we can make sure the trip can go ahead. As ever, we would welcome offers of help from any parents who are able to come along for the day.
