Time Lapse Movie Competition

Having experimented with making time lapse movies in school, I thought it might be fun to encourage the children to have a go at this fascinating activity at home. Essentially, a time lapse movie allows us to view a speeded-up version of a process that would otherwise be too slow to perceive, such as, for example, seeds germinating.

All that's needed is access to a smart phone or tablet-type device installed with a time lapse app, many of which are free to download.

I would advise choosing a subject that is likely to make some appreciable change over a period of anything between an hour and up to a day. Worthwhile subjects might include how shadows change during the course of the day, ice melting, dough rising, clock hands, snails eating a leaf, chromatography and so on. The possibilities are endless. A small prize will be awarded to the best and perhaps most creative examples from Key Stages One and Two.

Entries can either be emailed into school or brought in on a memory stick. We will then upload them to the school website. The closing date is Wednesday 28th February which allows time to experiment with ideas over the half term break.
