We would like to thank the staff, children and parents who have made cash donations already and would like to say that we are still accepting donations. These donations will be used to complete the building project started 2 years ago for a new wing in the school. We would also like to take this opportunity to inform you that in the past Redhill has helped to dig a well in order to arrange drinking water facilities for the children and raised funds to build 23 new toilets, without which the school was under the threat of closure. Hence, your donations have achieved a great deal already!

The Executive Committee are also organising a cake sale next week on Tuesday 6th February. If you can donate some cakes, we would be very grateful. Homemade and shop bought - both are welcome! Cakes will be taken around to the classrooms on Tuesday and will cost £1 per bag. Please do not send money to the office. Thank you.
